

City Council Meeting, March 9, 2016

The Fayetteville City Council met in regular session on March 9, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. in the Community Center Meeting Room. Those present to witness were Mayor Ron Pflughaupt, Councilpersons Marino, Cushing, Malota and Gillespie, plus visitors. Councilmember Pavlicek was absent.

Mayor Pflughaupt called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag and declared a quorum was present. Mayor Pflughaupt welcomed visitors.

The treasurer's report was next on the agenda. The report showed a balance of \$56,698.43 in the General Fund and \$42,797.29 in the Systems Fund. A motion was made by Councilman Marino, seconded by Councilman Gillespie, that Council approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.

Bills were presented to Council to review next on the agenda. After reviewing the bills, a motion was made by Councilman Marino, seconded by Councilperson Cushing, that Council approve payment of February 2016 bills and the usual bills that come in late. Motion carried.

Mayor Pflughaupt presented to Council a proposal to contract City Election to Dina Bell, Election Administrator, for the upcoming elections. Motion was made by Councilman Marino, seconded by Councilman Gillespie. Motion carried.

Updates were given on the projects assigned to Council members by Mayor Pflughaupt. Councilman Marino updated the Council on the Flag Project. Council was also updated on the Veterans Memorial and Hotel Occupancy Taxes. These projects are currently ongoing.

Request was made for comments from Council members. Councilperson Cushing requested that lighting to illuminate walkways, donated to the City by The Fayetteville Vision Committee and resident Don Mendell, be considered for installation. Mayor Pflughaupt said that all lighting to the property would need approval by the Architectural Board of Fayetteville.

A special City Council meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, March 16, 2016 to discuss the water well and Engineering bids for the project.
