

The Fayetteville City Council met in regular session on April 8, 2015 at 7:00 P.M. in the Community Center Meeting Room. Those present to witness were Mayor Ron Pflughaupt, Councilpersons Marino, Malota, Pavlicek, Conway and Gillespie, plus a few visitors.

Mayor Pflughaupt called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag and declared a quorum was present. Mayor Pflughaupt welcomed the visitors.

Minutes of both the February and March meetings were tabled, and will be approved at the next City Council Meeting on May 13, 2015.

The Treasurer's report was next on the agenda. The report showed a balance of \$24,467.08 in the General Fund and \$48,575.58 in the Systems Fund. A motion was made by Councilman Marino, seconded by Councilman Pavlicek, that Council approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.

The reading of bills was presented to Council to review. A motion was made by Councilman Pavlicek, seconded by Councilman Gillespie, that Council approve payment of March 2015 bills and usual bills that come in late. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilperson Malota, seconded by Councilman Marino to close Fayette St. from the square to HWY 159 (next to Country Place Hotel) for The Fayetteville Chamber Music Festival Music Concerts. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Pavlicek, seconded by Councilman Marino to accept Dina Bells' contract for administration of the City Election, held May 9th, 2015. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Pavlicek, seconded by Councilperson Malota act upon an Ordinance Amending the Ordinance Regulating Manufactured Homes, Mobile Homes and Travel Trailers, adopted on June 11th 2003, as Amended on April 8th, 2015, correcting section and legal references within the Ordinance, and further providing for Travel Trailer Utility Service Requirements. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Pavlicek, seconded by Councilman Gillespie to act upon the Historic Preservation Boards' recommendation for the lights on the square. Motion carried

A motion was made by Councilman Gillespie, seconded by Councilman Marino on scheduling a workshop for a seminar on the City Hotel Motel Tax. Motion Carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Marino, seconded Councilperson Gillespie to approve the Fayetteville Chamber of Commerce to use the square for City Wide Garage sale, on July 11th, 2015. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilperson Pavlicek, seconded Councilperson Conway to have an appraisal for repairs to the Seth Thomas Clock. Motion Carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Gillespie, seconded by Councilperson Conway to add the approved minutes of the City Council Meeting on the City Website. Motion Carried, 3 for 2 against.
