

City Council Meeting, October 14, 2015

The Fayetteville City Council met in regular session on October 14, 2015 at 7:00 P.M. in the Community Center Meeting Room. Those present to witness were Mayor Ron Pflughaupt, Councilpersons Marino, Malota, Cushing, Pavlicek and Gillespie, plus visitors.

Mayor Ron Pflughaupt called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag and declared a quorum was present. Mayor Ron Pflughaupt welcomed the visitors.

The Council approved the September 9, 2015 meeting minutes as presented.

The treasurer's report was next on the agenda. The report showed a balance of \$20,997.88 in the General Fund and \$51,636.79 in the Systems Fund. A motion was made by Councilperson Malota, seconded by Councilman Marino, that Council approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.

Bills were presented to Council to review next on the agenda. After reviewing the bills, a motion was made by Councilman Pavlicek, seconded by Councilperson Malota, that Council approve payment of September 2015 bills and the usual bills that come in late. Motion carried.

A representative from the railroad, Mr. Travis from TxDot and James Weishuhn, engineer, were present at the meeting and gave information on the possible railroad crossing closures in the City. Their mission is to work with the City for safe and reliable transportation solutions.

A motion was made by Councilman Marino, seconded by Councilman Pavlicek, that Council approve a resolution authorizing publication of notice of intention to issue combination tax and utility system surplus revenue certificates of obligation. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Marino, seconded by Councilman Gillespie, that Council approve the sewer line extension on N. Rusk Street. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Pavlicek, seconded by Councilman Marino, that Council approve acting on Ordinance #2015-10-14 which would establish the monthly water and sewer rates for the City of Fayetteville. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Pavlicek, seconded by Councilperson Malota, that Council approve adopting the City Budget for fiscal year 2016. Motion carried.

The Water Superintendent's report for the month of September 2015:

Total gallons pumped	1,734,000 gallons
Maximum gallons pumped	83,000 gallons
Minimum gallons pumped	33,000 gallons
Average daily gallons pumped	55,935 gallons

Water and sewer samples results for the month of September 2015 came back good.

There being no further action items on the agenda, a motion was made and seconded to adjourn the meeting, time 8:25 P.M. Motion carried.
