

City Council Meeting, May 13, 2015

The Fayetteville City Council met in regular session on May 13, 2015 at 7:00 P.M. in the Community Center Meeting Room. Those present to witness were Mayor Ron Pflughaupt, Councilpersons Marino, Malota, Conway, Pavlicek and Gillespie, plus visitors.

Mayor Pflughaupt called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag and declared a quorum was present. Mayor Pflughaupt welcomed the visitors.

Corrected minutes of the February 11, 2015 meeting were approved and March 11, 2015 meeting minutes were approved as presented.

The treasurer's report was heard next on the agenda. She reported a balance of \$24,467.08 in the General Fund and \$48,575.58 in the Systems Fund. A motion was made by Councilperson Malota, seconded by Councilman Marino, that Council approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.

The reading of bills was presented to Council to review. After reviewing the bills, a motion was made by Councilman Pavlicek, seconded by Councilman Gillespie, that Council approve payment of April 2015 bills and the usual bills that come in late. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilperson Conway, seconded by Councilperson Gillespie, that Council approve Fayetteville Chamber of Commerce using the Square for the City-wide Garage Sale on July 10 and 11, 2015. Motion carried,

Terry McPhearson addressed the Council on possible variance to Ordinance #6-11-2003 for RV parking spaces. Ordinance will be needed to grant variance. No vote was taken on this matter.
