

SPECIAL CALLED CITY COUNCIL MEETING MAY 18, 2016

The Fayetteville City Council met in Special Called Meeting May 18, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. in the Community Center Meeting Room. Those present to witness canvassing of the votes in the City Election held May 7, 2016 were Mayor Pflughaupt and Councilpersons Marino, Malota, Pavlicek, Cushing and Gillespie.

Mayor Ron Pflughaupt called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag and declared a quorum was present.

A motion was made by Councilman Marino, seconded by Councilperson Malota to accept the election results from the Fayette County Election Officials hired to administer the Election.
